

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2013

Rules & Regulations Ufa, Russia 1-20 of June 2013



General organization

- The organization of the World Championship 2013 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Russian International Draughts Federation and will take place in Ufa from June 1st (arrival) till June 20th (departure).
- 2. The forty (40) participants are qualified according to a schema accepted by the FMJD General Assembly 2011 (in alphabetic order of country name):

- 3. The tournament will be supervised by main referee ir Frank Teer.
- 4. Reserve players. Until April 30^{th,} 2013 the confederations may replace a player if that player cannot come. For the direct places from the World Championship 2011 the replacement is made from that World Championship and for the organisation and sponsor place the

- federation may replace the player. After that the player will be replaced by a reserve player nominated by the Executive Board of the FMJD.
- All players are obligated to send a copy of Russian Visa (if needed) and ticket to Ufa <u>before</u>
 <u>May 10th</u>. This should be sent to FMJD Tournament Director. Each player who did not send
 it on time will be replaced by reserve player.

Finances

- 6. All expenses for the traveling of players and visa costs are on charge of their federations as well as traveling, lodging and visa expenses for accompanying persons and /or Officials of delegations. Costs for lodging and food of the players are on charge of the organization:
 - 6.1. from June 1th (arriving day) till June 20th (departure):
 - a) For the top 12 player (finalists)
 - b) For players who did not qualify for the finals but who continue to play in Final-B
 - 6.2. from June 1th (arriving day) till June 10th (departure):
 - a) For players who did not qualify for the finals and do not participate in Final-B
- 7. The national federations presenting players have to pay the registration fee of their players to the FMJD, according to the regulation of the General Assembly. A player for whom the registration fee is not paid before the first round, is not allowed to participate in the tournament. Competitions fee per player: €110 or €220 (depend on federation status). All players must be present for the opening ceremony.

Format of the tournament

- 9. Semi-finals
 - 9.1. All 40 players will be divided into 4 round-robin semi-final tournaments.
 - 9.2. Composition of the groups.

The players will be divided into the groups in order of ratings (see appendix A – Participants rating list) with the rule, that players from one country (if less than 5) cannot be in the same group. If the participants list will be changed, the rating list of participants will be re-ordered.

Group A \rightarrow 1, 8, 9, 16, 17, 24, 25, 32, 33, 40

Group B \rightarrow 2, 7, 10, 15, 18, 23, 26, 31, 34, 39

Group $C \rightarrow 3, 6, 11, 14, 19, 22, 27, 30, 35, 38$

Group D \rightarrow 4, 5, 12, 13, 20, 21, 28, 29, 36, 37

9.3. Paring in groups. The drawing of numbers in the groups will be done during the opening ceremony with the condition that players from the same country have to meet before the 5th round.

- 9.4. The best 3 players from each semi-final go to the final tournament.
- 10. Final B
 - 10.1. All players not qualified for the final may participate in Final B
 - 10.2. Final B will be played as a 9 rounds Swiss tournament.
 - 10.3. The organization has the right to include new players into this tournament.

Final tournament

- 11. The final tournament will be played as round-robin tournament with 12 players. Semi-final games between qualified players from the same group are counted for the final.
- 12. Drawing will be done just after the last round in the semi finals. The following rules will be used:

- 12.1. players from group A get the numbers from 1 to 3
- 12.2. players from group B get the numbers from 4 to 6
- 12.3. players from group C get the numbers from 7 to 9
- 12.4. players from group D get the numbers from 10 to 12
- 12.5. Numbers for the players from the same country:
 - a) If 6 players from the same country \rightarrow 1, 4, 7, 10, 2, 5 (numbers for groups should be changed accordingly)
 - b) If 5 players from the same country → 1, 4, 7, 10, 2 (numbers for groups should be changed accordingly)
 - c) If 4 or less players from the same country, all should receive number from one of the pool:
 - A. 1, 4, 7, 10
 - B. 2, 5, 8, 11
 - C. 3, 6, 9, 12

Rules for all round-robin groups including final:

- 14. If two or more players end with the same score the following factors will be used to define the places occupied:
 - 14.1. the largest number of victories
 - 14.2. largest difference between plus and minus draws
 - 14.3. largest number of plus draws
 - 14.4. the best results between the tied players
 - 14.5. the best results obtained in order of the classification

in comparing the results between the players a plus draw is better than a normal draw which is better than a minus draw

- 15. If all criteria from the previous point will not decide about the final order:
 - 15.1. for the places 1, 2 or 3 a deciding tie-break will be played: One tie-break with system Lehmann-Georgiev (15 minutes and 2 seconds added per move for an unlimited number of games). If more players share the place then a round robin tournament with L-G games (10 minutes and 2 seconds). The number of minutes to start with may be changed by the main referee depending on the number of players ending ex-aequo and the time available, if necessary after consultation with the Tournament Director FMJD and the organization.
- 15.2. for the places 4- ... the places will be shared (prizes will be divided)
 16. "Plus Draw"
 - 16.1. When the result of a game is a draw and when there is a difference of 3 men or more (a king counting for two men, e.g. 2 kings and 1 man against 1 king) then the player with the majority gets a <u>plus draw</u> and his opponent receives a <u>minus draw</u>. This rule holds for the draw by mutual consent (see Annex 1 article 7) and for the regulatory draw (See Annex 1, article 6: three times the same position, the 25 moves rule, the 16 moves rule and the 5 moves rule). The players write a 1+ or 1- on their notation forms.
 - 16.2. If a position of a king plus 2 men against a King is reached then, as given in Annex 1 article 6.3, a maximum of 16 moves may be played. If the game is not yet ended the result is a plus draw for the player with the 3 pieces, unless 2 of the 3 pieces are not yet King and their promotion can be prevented by the player with one King.
 - 16.3. If it is clear for both players that the game will end in a plus draw they may agree upon a plus draw even if the difference of three men is not yet reached on the board.
 - 16.4. If it is clear for both players that the game will end in an equal draw they may agree upon such a draw even if there is a difference of three men or more on the board.
- 17. Specific rules for players delay:
 - 17.1. Every player who will not be present at the start of the opening ceremony will be deleted from the participants list.
 - 17.2. Delaying for the round. Players have to come in time to the playing hall, not later than exactly on the time the games are scheduled to start.
 - a) 1st penalty 100€ (can be subtracted from the prizes)
 - b) each next time a player is too late the game will be declared lost for him

Others

- 18. The first place gives right to the title of 'World Champion International Draughts 2013'.
- 19. Rights from this World Championship for the title match 2014 and the World Championship 2015
 - 19.1. If the titleholder keeps the title, the number two will be Challenger.

- 19.2. If the titleholder loses the title, he will be the Challenger.
- 19.3. Players qualified for the World Championship 2015:
 - a) The new world champion
 - b) The challenger
 - c) 1 other player in the order of the final classification.
- 20. The players finishing in the first three places will receive a medal and an official diploma.
- 21. According to the rule adopted in the General Assembly of Abidjan 1996, it is forbidden to smoke in the playing hall. All other prohibitions written down in Annex 3 are also valid.
- 22. The board of the FMJD will compose a jury to award three FMJD prices:
 - 22.1. the Roozenburg-cup (best game for winner and loser)
 - 22.2. the Springer-cup (best endgame)
 - 22.3. the Weiss-cup (best combination)
- 23. The Jury d'Appel will be announced during the opening ceremony.

- 26. In the case of something being not clear in the FMJD regulations or in this special regulation, the decision will be made by the main referee in consultation with the organization and the FMJD tournament Director.
