

# WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BLITZ 2013

## Rules & Regulations



1. The organization of the World Championship Blitz 2013 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Royal Dutch Draughts Federation (KNDB) and will take place from December 21<sup>st</sup> till December 22<sup>nd</sup>.

2. Participants:

Tournament is open for each player who accepts these rules & regulations.

3. Playing room:

Building Dok 51 – Willemsoord 51 1780 AD Den Helder, The Netherlands

4. Games rate – 5'+3”

5. On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Championship the qualifications will be played. Preferably as a number of Round Robin tournaments (depending on number of participants). On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day a final with 18 players will be played. Round Robin system will be applied.

6. All FMJD rules (specially Annex VI) are valid.

7. Competition fee is **60€** or **120€** depending on country status in FMJD. This should be paid to FMJD

8. Any protest to Jury d'Appel should be given in written form (in English) to the main referee not later than 10 minutes after the game. Each protest is valid only after paying a deposit of 100 euro. The deposit will be returned only if a protest will be accepted.
