Topic: 18th Pan-American Senior International Draughts Championship.

Dear All,

The PADCF inform and invite you that the **18th Pan-American senior International Draughts Championship** will be hosted by the Brazilian Draught Federation in Sao Paulo in the period of **12 -19 April 2015.**

The 18th Pan-American Senior International Draughts Championship is a world qualifying tournament (2 places) for the **world International senior Championship 2015.**

In the 18th Pan-American Senior International Draughts Championship each member association can participate with two (2) players.

In addition, all past Pan American Champions have the right to play the 18th Pan-American Senior International Draughts Championship.

The organizing country will play with 3 players and one sponsor player

Note:

From this championship only one (1) player from the same country can qualify for the WC 2015.

The Brazilian Draughts Association will further arrange "free":

1. Full accommodation/lodging for the first player, main and assistant arbiter
2. Transport from and to the airport.
3. Coffee, tea, water during the games.
4. Giving awards (trophies and medals) to the best 5 players

Others:

- The subscription fee per players is \$100,- USA (this for each players)
- Each second country player must pay \$300,-
- All coaches and/or accompanying persons must pay \$300,- each, for their lodging and food during the championship. (Max. two (2) person per room.


