

## Contents:

1. proposal of the FMJD Executive Board for separate membership of the section 64 Russian/Brazilian.

1. proposal of the FMJD Executive Board for separate membership of the section 64 Russian/Brazilian.

The Executive Board proposes to give the section 64 Russian/Brazilian the right to ask federations participating in their tournaments to explicitly become member of the section to be able to participate in their tournaments under the normal conditions.

2. Proposal of the FMJD Executive Board that the section 64 Russian/Brazilian may ask their own membership fee.

Asking this fee has become more logical, as the FMJD membership fee has dropped from 460 or 230 to 120 Euro by the e-vote in October-December 2013.

On several occasions there has been a discussion about the possibility for the section 64 Russian/Brazilian to have their own membership fee or about the question whether part of the FMJD membership fee should be paid to the section 64.

The WCDF / section Checkers has its own membership fee and the FMJD statutes also describe that FMJD sections have the right to ask for their own "organization allowance".

The General Assembly of the section 64 Russian/Brazilian has the right to decide about this fee, whether they are going to ask for it and how high it will be.

3. Proposal from Poland and Brazil.

To create a new section Brazilian Draughts or International Draughts on 64 squares, working in close cooperation with the FMJD Executive Board.

The Polish federation has amended this proposal in February 2014 to include that the existing section 64 Russian/Brazilian will be renamed to the "section 64 Russian Draughts".
